

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type blade carriages rated by the fork carriage lifting capability. Hook type blade carriages have been uniform.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
